
"Aldridge - Secrets from The Lodge is a small publication tracing the almost unknown history of an 18th Century manor house/shooting lodge located on the fringes of Walsall. A significant portion of the book gives a focus to the period from 1937 when it provided accommodation for a minimum of 50 Spanish/Basque refugee children and their carers.

The author provides details about the arrangements made before and during the period when Aldridge Lodge provided a safe haven for children generally under 14 years of age escaping the horrors of the Spanish Civil War.



Uniquely, from the records quoted in the book the daily lives of the children and their carers provide a revealing insight. It traces the co-operation between the local council (especially named councillors who were champions of the project) and other sympathetic organisations at a time when the government of the day felt unable to officially support the work at The Lodge and other similar colonies."
