at Lancing, from a child repatriated from there to
Bilbao, Feb 17th 1938.

Bilbao, march 9th 1938.

.....Here there is sufficient (i.e. for other people)
but as far as we are concerned it is just as if there
was not, because our Daddy cannot
We are far too numerous to be supported by a single
wage, therefore we shall soon lose all that we gained
with you; but so long as our health lasts we can carry
on. Please tell Senorita R. that I sent her a ---
--- (i.e. prearranged signal that conditions were bad
and that they needed help) and ask her to write again
very soon.

This child is aged 15 and was returned with two smaller
sisters.
