The Natalia Benjamin Prize

(English Language)

Undergraduate students are invited to submit a long essay or dissertation in English on any aspect of the evacuation of the Basque Children to the United Kingdom.

The judges will be academics based in universities in the United Kingdom; they will consider the originality, depth of research, contribution made by the piece, strength of the argument and quality of the prose.

Essays and dissertations for this prize can be from 10,000 - 15,000 words. The winner will receive £100 and the winning essay will be published on the website of the BCA'37 UK -the Association for the UK Basque Children.

Entry form

Your entry should include the following details on a separate page.

1. Prize for which you are submitting your entry, i.e. *Natalia Benjamin Prize* or *Spanish/Basque prize*. Candidates may make <u>only one</u> entry either for the English or for the Spanish/Basque prize.

 Personal details: Your full name. Your contact address, email and telephone number.

3. The University or College that you are attending: Name, department and address; course title and year of study.

4. Your entry: Title of submission. Abstract/summary.

Submissions should be emailed (as an attachment) to prize@basquechildren.org with the subject line "2021 Prize".

Submissions should be received by midnight, 30 September 2021. You must have permission to use copyrighted material and give acknowledgements where needed.

The judges' decisions are final.

If any submission commits plagiarism or violates copyright, the author of the essay is solely responsible for the act(s). BCA'37 UK will NOT take any responsibility in case of plagiarism and/or copyright infringement. The University will be informed.
